Guidelines

- **IMPORTANT:** Abstract submissions are limited to 1 submission per corresponding author. Presenters are only permitted 1 presentation within the official program.
- Only submissions submitted in English will be considered. Please ensure you thoroughly check your submission for spelling and grammatical errors as accepted abstracts/full papers will be printed as per your submission.
- Abstract submissions should be no longer than 2 pages in length.
- Please ensure any acronyms are spelt out in the first instance.
- Ensure that all author information (names, affiliations and presenting author biography) is included and entered correctly.
- No abstracts/full papers will be accepted for review after the published deadlines.
- You are encouraged to nominate up to but no more than 5 keywords with your submission. These can be included in your abstract submission and within the submission process.
- Presenting authors are asked to provide a biography in third person and no longer than 120 words.
- Student submitters have the opportunity to have their submission considered for the Tsai Award. This award is only available to students and submitters need to indicate their preference during the submission process.

Important template information

It is required that all submissions use the provided Microsoft Word submission template. If submitters fail to use this template their submission will be rejected.

The abstract submission template can be downloaded on the official ICCM22 website. This is an easy to use Microsoft Word template and all submissions **must be completed in this format and then converted to PDF prior to submission.**

It is important to name your file in the following pattern:
first name_lastname_ICCM22.

The full paper submission template is still being formulated and will be made available closer to the full paper submission open date.

Terms and conditions

By submitting an abstract/full paper all authors agree to the below terms and conditions.

- Submitting authors must declare that the abstract/s submitted are the original work of at least one author/presenter.
- If the abstract/full paper is accepted as an oral and/or poster, at least one abstract author will register, pay and attend ICCM22.
- Presenting authors are required to register and pay for the conference. No funding is provided to presenters.
- If the abstract/full paper is selected, consent is provided for the presentation slides (for oral presenters), video, audio recording and photos taken during the oral presentation/poster presentation to be used and published by ICCM22 including being provided to delegates of ICCM22.
- Submitting authors must declare the work described in the abstract/full paper has appropriate approval under local, ethical and animal experimentation rules.
- Submitting authors must declare that their work does not conflict with any existing copyright agreements with alternate publishers.
